

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1. Rule Requirement – Federal CCR Rule §257.80(c)

Under Federal Rule 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §257.80(c), GHD prepared this *Annual Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Fugitive Dust Control Report* following the initial CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan November 2025 for the former Humboldt Station ash pond formerly operated by Corn Belt Power Cooperative (Corn Belt). Subsequent annual reports are due one year from the previous report date.

This Annual Fugitive Dust Control report is for November 2025 through May 2026.

The Annual Fugitive Dust Control Report includes:

1. A description of the actions taken to control CCR fugitive dust (Section 2).
2. A record of all citizen complaints (Section 3).
3. A summary of any corrective measures taken to address dust control (Section 4).

A copy of this report will be placed in the operating record as required under §257.105(g)(2).

2. Description of the actions taken to control CCR fugitive dust

2.1 Site access control

The majority of the former Humboldt Station is fenced with a locked gate at the north end at the entrance road. The river-facing boundary of the property is not fenced. There is no ready access from the Des Moines River to the ash pond. Site security aids in the prevention of CCR disturbance.

2.2 Wind sheltering and vegetation

Although the former ash pond is not covered, it is stabilized by time, vegetation, leaf litter, and detritus. The ash pond surface is below the surrounding grade providing a wind buffer. The CCR observed at and near the surface includes slag and bottom ash. No fly ash which is subject to drying and blowing in the wind is located near the surface.

3. Record of all citizen complaints

A procedure to log citizen complaints is identified in Section 4 of the CCR Fugitive Dust Control Plan, created November 2025 (GHD, 2025).

No citizen complaints were received during the 2025-2026 reporting period.

4. Summary of corrective measures

No fugitive dust-related corrective measures were required during the reporting period.
